







Administration challenges summary

- To recruit and retain experienced colleagues.
- To maintain Service Standards at the 90% plus target for all our key areas of activity.
- Key Projects / Activities
 - My Pension Portal (MPP)
 - National Pensions Dashboard Programme
 - TRP New General Code of Practice
 - McCloud (Pensions Remedy)

My Pension Portal





My Pension Portal (MPP)

- Continue to promote and encourage wider use of My Pension Portal.
- Scheme members can run calculations and update personal information.
 - 49% Active scheme members registered
 - 31% Deferred scheme members registered
 - 27% Pensioner scheme members registered



Future Developments for My Pension Portal

- Current service, My Pension Portal, is to be switched off on 31 January 2026.
- Our Pensions administration software provider, Heywood, are to introduce replacement product - Engage.
- Likely to take around 3 months to migrate from current platform to new platform.
- Staffordshire Pension Fund targeting September 2025 for implementation/upgrade.
- New service designed to be more user friendly for phones/tablets and more interactive.
- The new portal for Scheme members includes all features currently in My Pension Portal.
- Scheme Employer assistance in communicating change will be appreciated.



Pensions Dashboards Programme





National Pensions Dashboard Programme

- Getting Dashboard Ready
 - Programme aims to reconnect savers with their pension pots (estimated 2.8m lost pots in UK)
 - Integrated Service Provider (ISP) appointed in March 2024 to ensure the Fund connects to the dashboard infrastructure.
 - Connection date for LGPS confirmed as 31 October 2025
 - Fund to work on data cleansing and data matching exercise (find & view data)
 - Phase 1 project commenced 4 November 2024 (10 weeks)
 - Phase 2 Live connection to the ecosystem scheduled for July 2025.

Administration challenges

- TPR issued a new general code of practice on 28 March 2024 covering
 - Administration, Funding & Investment
 - Governing Bodies, Communications & Disclosure
 - Reporting to TPR
- Main challenge was to interpret new code as different terminology and structure.
- Compliance checker purchased to help assess adherence to the new code and record evidence
- Whilst for most areas we are fully compliant still work to do.
- Keep Pensions Committee & Board informed.

Administration challenges ahead...

McCloud Remedy Update - Recap

- Reforms to public sector pensions introduced 2014/2015.
- LGPS moved to CARE scheme.
- Protections introduced for older scheme members.
- December 2018 Court of appeal ruled discrimination for younger scheme member.
- LGPS regulations amended 1 October 2023, McCloud remedy.
- Most scheme members will not see an increase to their pension.



Administration challenges ahead (cont)...

McCloud Remedy - To Do List

- Disclose LGPS regulation changes to in scope scheme members by 31 December 2023.
- Collect final outstanding data from scheme employers by 31 December 2023.
- Apply McCloud remedy for benefit calculations from 1 October 2023.
- Revisit calculations for in scope scheme members (back to 1 April 2014).
- Annual Benefit Statements 2025 to include underpin test.



Phase one – data collection

- The first stage is to load all membership data (hours & service breaks) for remedy period.
- Circa 32k records in scope.
- 78% cases we are either happy with data held or uploaded revised data.
- Working through the more complex/difficult cases time consuming.
- McCloud tranche went live in Altair (19 July 24) creating a few administration challenges to business-as-usual.
- Priority planning for production of the 2025 Annual Benefit Statements, which must reflect any impact of McCloud.



Phase two -

- The second stage of the McCloud project is to review more complex records (concurrency, aggregation, transfers).
- Currently requires manual calculation of some benefit calculations e.g. separate
 McCloud 'add-on' calculation for transfer out spreadsheet to be completed in all cases.



Phase three - rectification

- The final stage is to revisit cases paid prior to switching on McCloud.
- McCloud Implementation Summary
 - remedy work to be concluded for most members by 31 August 2025.
 - remedy work to be completed for remaining members by 31 August 2026.
 - after this, McCloud expected to be part of 'business as usual'.
- We are not expecting many members to benefit from the McCloud underpin.

- 31,321 Active scheme member statements published (July 2024)
- 42,405 Deferred scheme member statements published (August 2024)

- Provided a general overview of the LGPS.
- 175 attendees on the call, thank you to all Scheme Employers who helped advertise the event.
